We are now seeking an enthusiastic and talented Music Teacher to join our committed, passionate and vibrant team. This part-time position offers a unique opportunity for the successful applicant to support the design and delivery of our school's music curriculum through teaching every child in our school on a weekly basis and leading our weekly 'Songs and Praise' collective worship. St Mary's is committed to supporting our team's wellbeing, so time will be built into the successful applicant's working hours for the non-teaching aspects of their role, including their safeguarded PPA time. We are eager to find a teacher who can bring a high level of creativity, passion, and expertise to this role.

Responsibilities:

- Further develop and deliver a comprehensive music curriculum for children from Reception to Year Four, fostering their musical abilities and love for music.
- Teach engaging weekly music lessons to each of our six classes, tailoring the content to suit their respective ages and current levels of attainment.
- Create a positive and inclusive learning environment that encourages children's participation and self-expression through music.
- Assess and evaluate student progress, providing constructive feedback and support to help students reach their full musical potential.
- Lead 'Songs and Praise' collective worship one afternoon per week, collaborating with the school community to provide a spiritually enriching experience.
- Aid in the planning and organisation of school-wide musical events, such as concerts, assemblies, and performances, showcasing the talents of our students.
- Collaborate with classroom teachers to integrate music into the wider curriculum, enhancing cross-curricular learning experiences.
- Network with local schools and participate in combined events and CPD.









Requirements:

- Qualified teacher status (QTS) or relevant music teacher training or experience which enables the applicant to teach music to whole classes of primary school-aged children – We are open to applications from qualified teachers (with QTS) and unqualified teachers (without QTS) who specialise in music teaching.
- Demonstrable experience of teaching music to classes of primary school-aged children.
- A passion for music and a strong understanding of various musical genres, instruments, and techniques, including the ability to sing and play the piano.
- Ability to inspire and engage students, fostering their creativity and confidence in music.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to work collaboratively with colleagues, parents, and the wider school community.
- Strong organisational skills, with the ability to plan and deliver effective lessons and events.
- Knowledge of the Early Years Foundation Stage, the DfE's Model Music Curriculum and relevant guidelines for music education in primary schools, including the revised National Plan for Music Education.
- Commitment to upholding the ethos and values of St Mary's CE VC First School.
