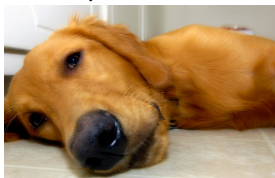


English

Beech: Children will use their bodies and instruments to listen and respond to pieces of classical music that represent animals. They will learn and perform a song as a class and compose a short section of music as a group, with a focus on dynamics and tempo.

Maple: Will learn to sing songs expressively. They will describe different images created by music and identify and use descriptive words to create sound pictures. They will select instruments to combine sounds carefully, choose carefully and order sounds within simple structures in response to a stimulus. They will create and perform a class composition.
