

English

Our writing will be connected to our topic and the stories related to the theme. We will write non-chronological reports, poetry and narratives inspired by the books we read. We will continue to use Lexia as part of weekly home learning to support our reading, spelling and grammar work.

Maths

We will be developing our understanding and reasoning in multiplication and division. We will use TTRockstars to develop speed and agility in tables recall. Children will take weekly speed tables tests to develop their tables skills and this is called the 99 Club. We will work on fractions and measures for length, perimeter, mass and capacity.

Science

This term we will be learning about forces and magnets. We will be developing our understanding of teeth, diet, and digestion.

French - will include classroom instructions, numbers 1-20, animals, colours, the story of the Brown Bear, Plurals and adjectives.
