English

In the first half term we will be writing our own alien space stories based on the film clip Invasion. We will read the book Hidden Figures and then write a biography of famous woman connected to space. After half term we will read Ted Hughes Iron Man and work on settings, characters and plot lines in our stories and then write our own set of instructions.

Maths

This term we will focus on our place value skills working with numbers to 10,000. Then we will move onto addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. All the time we will continue working on improving our rapid recall of times tables. Keep practicing these at home

Science

In the first half of the term we will look at electricity and be building circuits, looking at insulators and conductors and building our own switches. After half term we will become experts in States of Matter! Developing an understanding of all areas of states of matter, including how materials can change from one to another

French

This term focuses on numbers 1-31, months, dates, asking for and giving birthdays and special days, language to do with birthday and special day celebrations and Christmas vocabulary. Children will use the new language to understand and create invitations, they will learn about how Epiphany is celebrated in France, understand songs, stories and videos about birthdays and other special celebrations.

Creative Arts
